In line with the Secretary-General's objective of strengthening partnership under Chapter VIII, the United Nations Liaison Office for Peace and Security (UNLOPS) in Vienna was established in October 2016 with the aim of supporting cooperation between the represented departments – **Department of Political and Peacebuilding Affairs (DPPA)**, **Department of Peace Operations (DPO)**, and **Department of Operational Support (DOS)** – and the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) on peace and security matters.
